Marigold, Disco Mix- <i>single flowers, early and floriferous</i>

Kale, Mix-the hardiest greens, colorful mix grown from organic seed.
Lacinato-tender blistered leaves. Organic seed.
Starbor-curly green, very hardy
Leek, Tadorna-hardy leek for fall and winter. Organic seed.
Lettuce mix-a colorful mix, organic seed.
Melon, Cantaloupe
Hannah's choice-selected for our climate
Tirreno-very sweet firm flesh. Organic seed.
Okra, Jambalaya-early compact variety
Onion, Cortland-yellow keeper. Organic seed.
Watermelon, Blacktail Mountain-heirloom, red and sweet. Organic seed.
Cream of Saskatchewan-short season heirloom, yellow flesh.
Peppers, hot
Anaheim, NuMex Joe E. Parker- multi purpose chile. Organic seed.
Ancho/ Poblano-the best for chile rellenos
Cayenne, Ring of Fire-easy to dry, hot. Organic seed.
Jalapeno -a favorite for salsa, organic seed
Cayenne, Joe's Long-easy to dry, hot. Organic seed.
Serrano, Hot Rod-popular Mexican hot pepper
Thai Hot-tiny red hots for Thai cuisine, organic seed.

Yankee Bell-big blocky green ripening to red bell. Organic seed.

Squash, summer, Zucchini Elite-open plants for easy picking
Golden glory-yellow squash with good flavor
Strawberry, Alexandria (HP)- sweet alpine type, no runners
Sarian (HP)- sweet medium size everbearing

Jasper -Early and late blight resistant, tall plant. Organic seed.
Mountain Magic-blight resistant sweet cocktail tomato
Red Grape-compact plants, very productive
Sungold-amazing sweet flavor, bite-size orange cherries

Black Krim-Russian heirloom, requested often. Organic seed.
Black Pineapple (Ananas Noir) sweet, colorful and large. Organic seed.

Kellogg's Breakfast- <i>orange, gigantic and sweet. Organic seed.</i>
Mrs. Benson- <i>an Illinois heirloom, pink and early. Organic seed.</i>
Tomatoes, Beefsteak
Big Beef- <i>large size and beautiful, early red beefsteak type</i>
Iron Lady- <i>late blight resistant. Organic seed.</i>
Jetstar- <i>disease resistant and dependable red, medium size tomato</i>
Tomatoes, Roma Type
Amish Paste- <i>large and productive, organic seed.</i>
San Marzano- <i>Italian paste tomato for sauce, late, organic seed.</i>
Tomatillo, Toma Verde- <i>indispensible for salsa. Organic seed.</i>

Thai- <i>purple stem, green leaves, authentic in Thai cooking. Organic seed.</i>
Cilantro, Calypso- <i>slowest bolting variety</i>
Lavender, Ellagance (HP)- <i>early, uniform & beautiful</i>
Lemon Balm (HP)- <i>great tea plant, organic seed.</i>
Mint (HP)- <i>great for tea, tabouli and garnish, but be careful. It spreads.</i>
Oregano (HP)- <i>easy to grow, great for Greek and Italian cooking. Organic seed.</i>
Parsley, Curly- <i>nutritious, deep green variety. Organic seed.</i>
Parsley, Flat Italian- <i>strong stems and good flavor. Organic seed.</i>
Rosemary (HP)- <i>a pine smelling herb, small needle-like leaves. Organic seed.</i>
Sage (HP)-- <i>a native American herb. Organic seed.</i>
Thyme (HP)- <i>indispensable and popular aromatic herb. Organic seed.</i>
